The **Galveston County Museum** opened in 1976. It was located on Market Street for many years. After Hurricane Ike damaged the HVAC and electrical systems in 2008, the unharmed artifacts were moved. Now the museum is located in the Galveston County courthouse building at 722 Moody/21st Street in Galveston. The museum cares for a collection of 20,000 artifacts and archives. The Museum also maintains the historical commission's library. **John Rodak, artist**, has an exhibit in the Museum and he will lead us on a tour of his pointillist, pen and ink art.
